We would like to invite you to propose symposia for the 2026 meeting of the **Canadian College of Neuropsychopharmacology** which will take place in the heart of downtown Toronto at the University of Toronto's iconic **Faculty Club** located at 41 Willcocks Street.

Symposia proposal should include (1) identification of the Chair(s), (2) a brief synopsis of the symposium theme (~ half a page), (3) a confirmed list of four speakers, including institutional affiliations, and (4) tentative titles plus a brief summary of each talk (3 - 4 sentences). Symposia should focus on topics that are timely and of broad interest to the CCNP membership. The organizing committee encourages multi-institutional submissions with a mix of clinical, translational and fundamental components, as well as junior and senior researchers. We encourage individuals from equity seeking groups such as women, racialized/visible minorities, Indigenous peoples, persons with disabilities and others who reflect the diversity of Canadian society to be included as presenters.

Proposals can be uploaded directly on the CCNP website (ccnp.ca). Applications will be assessed on a rolling basis, with a limited number of slots available. If you have any questions or concerns regarding uploading your proposal, please contact Trudy Valliere at trudyvalliere4@gmail.com.
